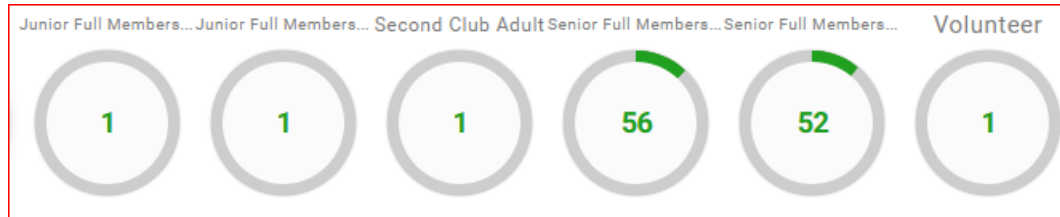

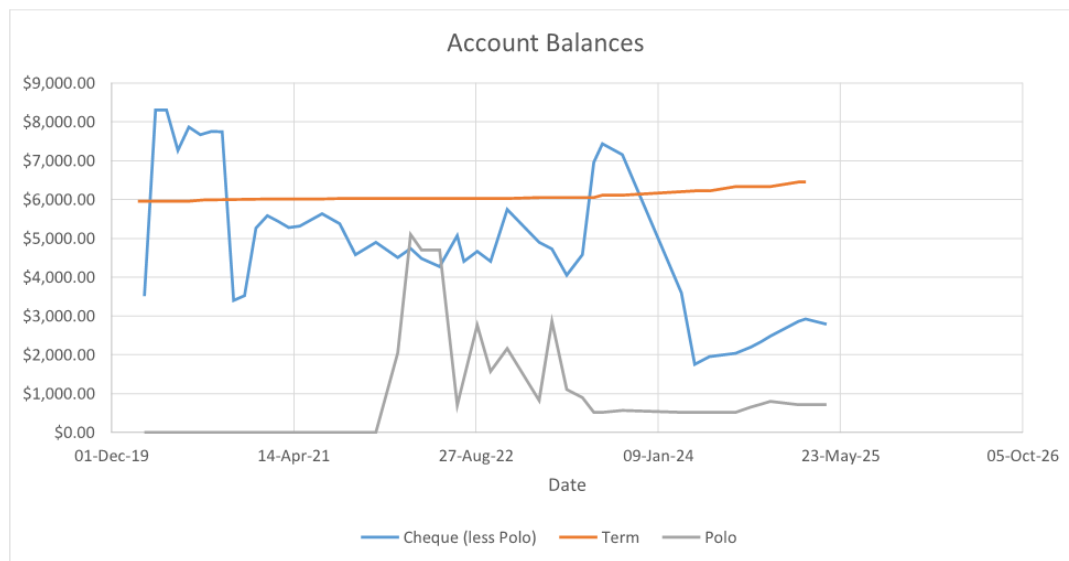

## **MEMBERSHIP REPORT**

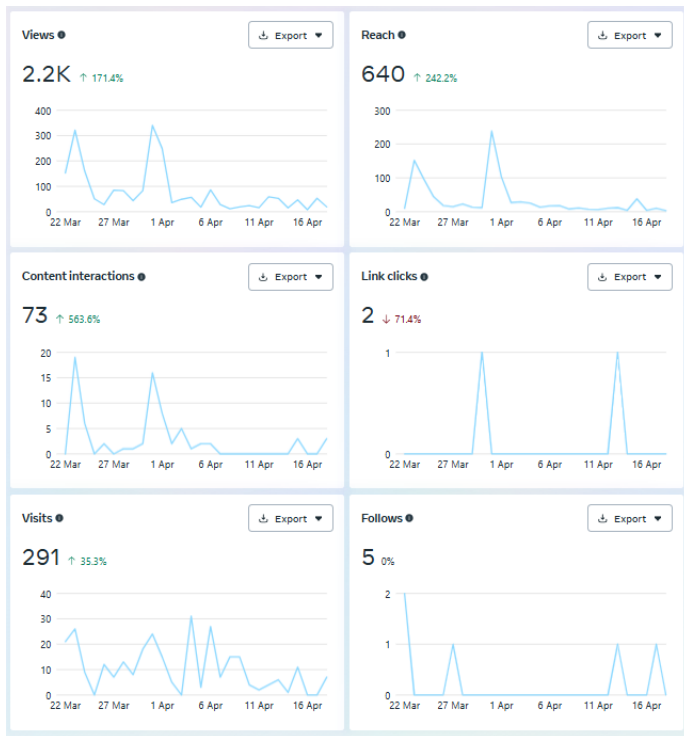
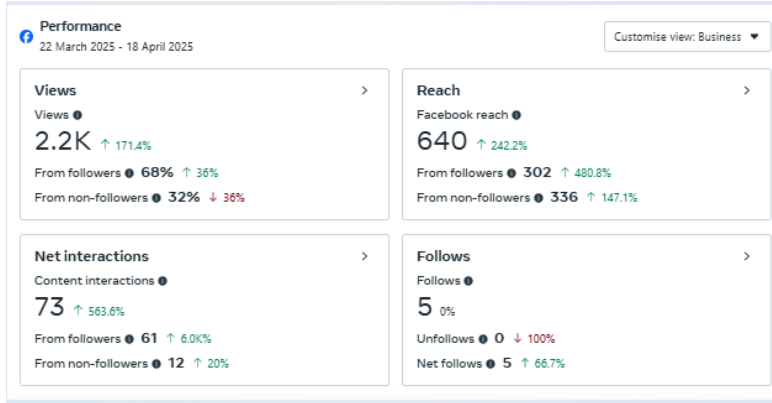
There have been three people who have linked their profile to the club. I have contacted them by email but no reply.

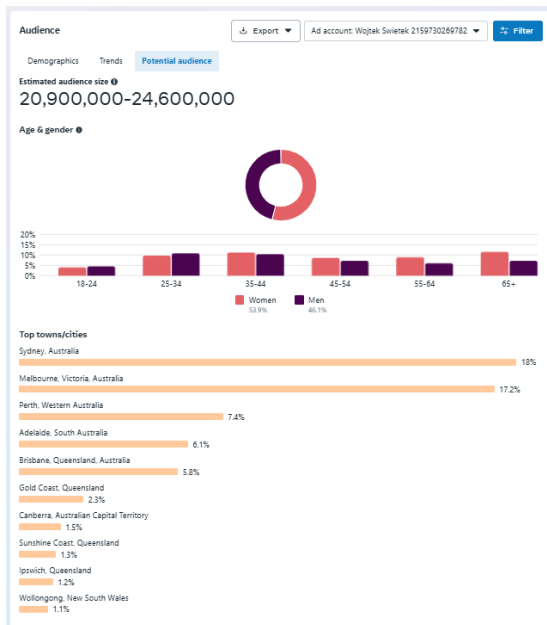
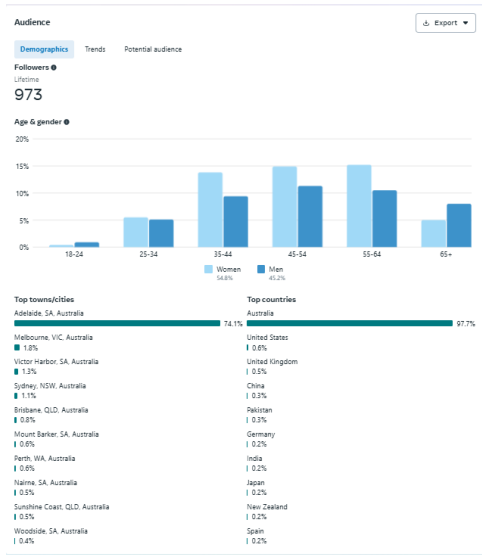
